Students manage to strike gold

TWO WERRIBEE students have been awarded the Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award. Chloe Dewar, 19, and Aiden Schier, 23, completed the youth development program over a 12-month period, taking on a range of physical activities, skills and community services.

The Heathdale Christian College graduates were presented with the award at the inaugural Gold Award Gala at the Melbourne Town Hall earlier this month.
